Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. is owned and operated by Ray and Ron VanMarrewyk. We are the 4th generation of Greenhouse growers in our family. 2 generations were in the Netherlands and we are the 2nd generation in Canada. Our family started in Pitt Meadows with a very small greenhouse back in 1969. Between 1970 and 1999 our parents expanded a number of times in Pitt Meadows with small increases. In 1999, our parents founded Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. by building its most significant greenhouse to date which was 18.4 acres and that greenhouse has always produced long English In 2006 Ray and Ron took over ownership of Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. and began to build another 17.6 acre greenhouse producing Sweet Bell Peppers. In 2014 another 18.5 acres of greenhouses was built and production started in March of 2015. In the future, Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. has the space to build another 18.5 acres which would bring the total area to about 73 acres on 2 properties in Delta, BC.

In 2006, Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. joined the Windset Farms marketing agency. Windset Farms has high expectations for its produce suppliers and we are proud to be part of their brand. Today Windset Farms has the exclusive rights to market over 500 acres of greenhouse crops, and has developed a tier one customer list including Costco Wholesale, Sam's Club, Walmart and Loblaws, all of whom are interested in securing year round supply of produce from Westcoast Vegetables Ltd. We package and ship in-house directly from our facilities to our customers to ensure the freshest product possible at the store level; you will find some of our product as far East as Montreal or as far South as Southern California!
